

Infant Participation in the CACFP

Your child care center/home participates in the USDA Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP). The CACFP must be available to all enrolled children, including infants. If you choose to enroll your infant in the CACFP, your child care provider must offer meals/snacks at no additional charge. As a parent/legal guardian, you have the right to determine whether your child will be enrolled in the Child and Adult Care Food Program.

The purpose of this form is to indicate your choice of CACFP participation for your infant.

Please indicate your choice of CACFP participation for your infant by checking one of the following statements and signing/dating the form:

- I breastfeed my baby. I choose to supply expressed breastmilk to my caregiver to administer at feeding time. Other foods (i.e. iron-fortified infant cereal, fruits/vegetables, meats) will be provided by my caregiver when age-appropriate, consistent with CACFP guidelines.
- I formula feed my baby. I choose to accept the iron-fortified infant formula _____ (list brand-name of formula) that is provided by my caregiver. In addition, my caregiver will provide other foods when age-appropriate, consistent with CACFP guidelines.
- I formula feed my baby, but I choose to supply my own formula that I have purchased or that has been supplied by the WIC Program. My caregiver will provide other foods to my child when age-appropriate, consistent with CACFP guidelines.
- I choose not to enroll my child in the CACFP at this time. I will provide all infant foods for my child.
- I am a family child care home provider. I choose to enroll my own infant in the CACFP. The child care meals served to my child is contingent on current Tier 1 determination based on my family's personal income.
